CHAPTER XIII

AMENDMENT AND EVALUATION

A. AMENDMENT

The Director is expressly charged with the responsibility of maintaining this Manual current. As the Pilgrim Church progresses, and the corporate and individual ministries of the Community evolve, changes to this Manual will inevitably be needed. Some changes will be dictated by higher authority in the Church, such as those changes necessitated by official interpretations of canon law, by pronouncements of the National Council of Catholic Bishops, or by revised Archdiocesan policy that is binding on the Community. Moreover, any person or organization may propose suggested changes to the Director.

All changes to this Manual, mandatory or suggested, shall receive approval at the same level as did the original Manual, that is the level of the Chancellor, the Judicial Vicar, and ultimately, the Archbishop.

B. EVALUATION

The requirements, policies, and procedures contained in this Manual, and their implementation, shall be evaluated every two years.
